

# Noordduinen Revitalisation

Beach rose and other ligneous plants to be controlled in the dunes

**Landschap Noord-Holland takes pleasure in inviting you to attend the international LIFE conference on Friday 28th June next. The event will commence in Hotel Callantsoog with inspiring lectures about the experience gained in the Noordduinen Revitalisation project.**

The Japanese rose (*Rosa rugosa*), which was planted in the past, covers 6 hectares of the rare grey dunes in this area. Landschap Noord-Holland had to make a great effort to considerably cut this plant back, so as to provide room to the biodiversity in the area to allow it to flourish again.

Water company PWN will be talking about their experience in fighting the black cherry (*Prunus serotina*) in the dunes. And furthermore their experience in fighting the sea buckthorn (*Hippophae rhamnoides*) in England, which is sometimes considered a pest over there. In the afternoon there will be an excursion to the Noordduinen.

We would like to share the experience gained in this varied programme. The official language of the conference will be English.
